



## How to word a legacy to Grove House in your existing Will or with a Codicil

If you are about to make your first Will it may be helpful to use the wording below if you want to include a gift to Grove House. If you have already made a Will, but would still like to leave a gift to Grove House, you can do so by making a simple addition to your existing Will. This is called a Codicil. By adding this supplement to your Will you can include new instructions or delete old ones without having to go through the task of rewriting the whole Will.

You can take this form to your Will Writer or Solicitor to give them the correct wording to be used. We recommend you should always consult with a solicitor or other legal advisor before writing or changing your Will.
